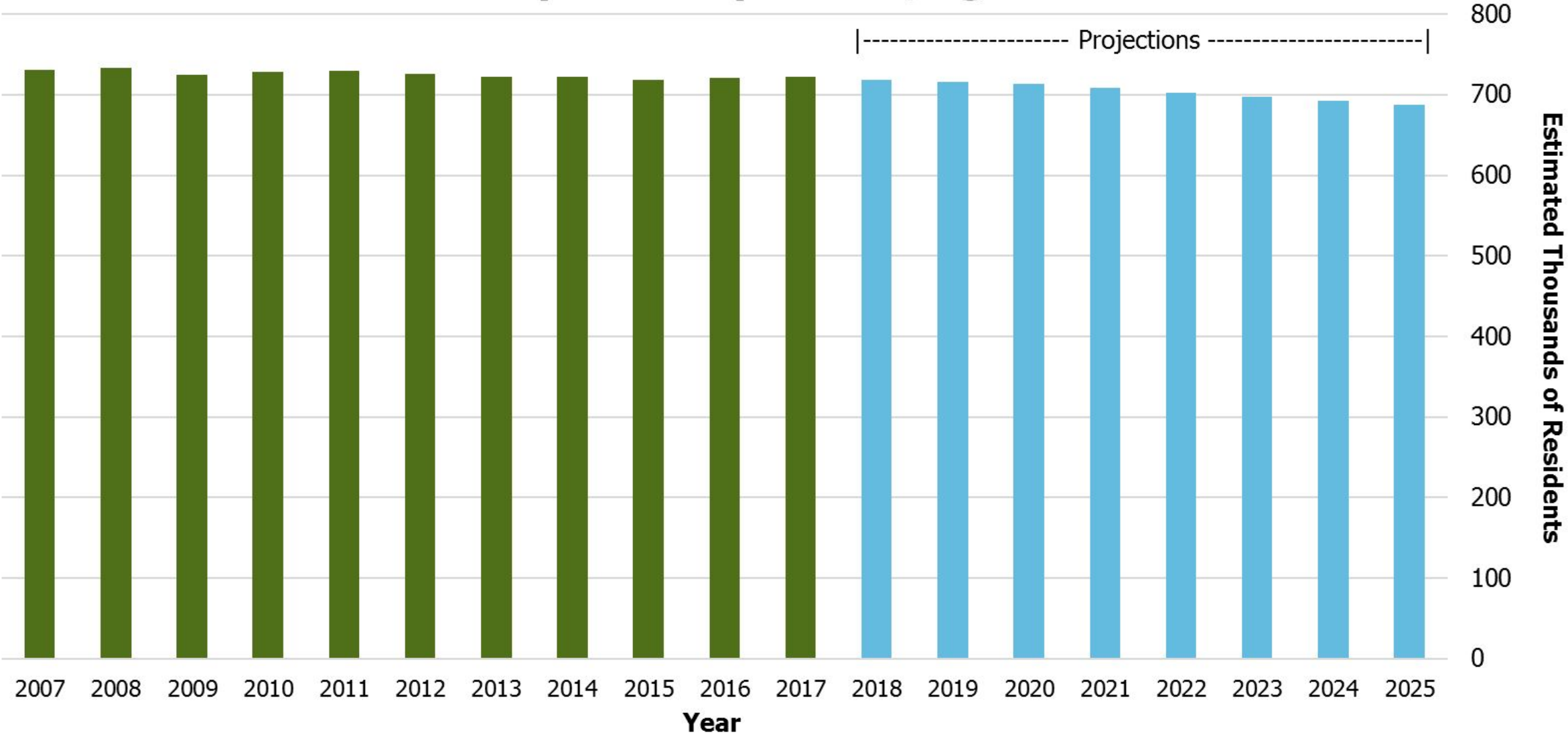

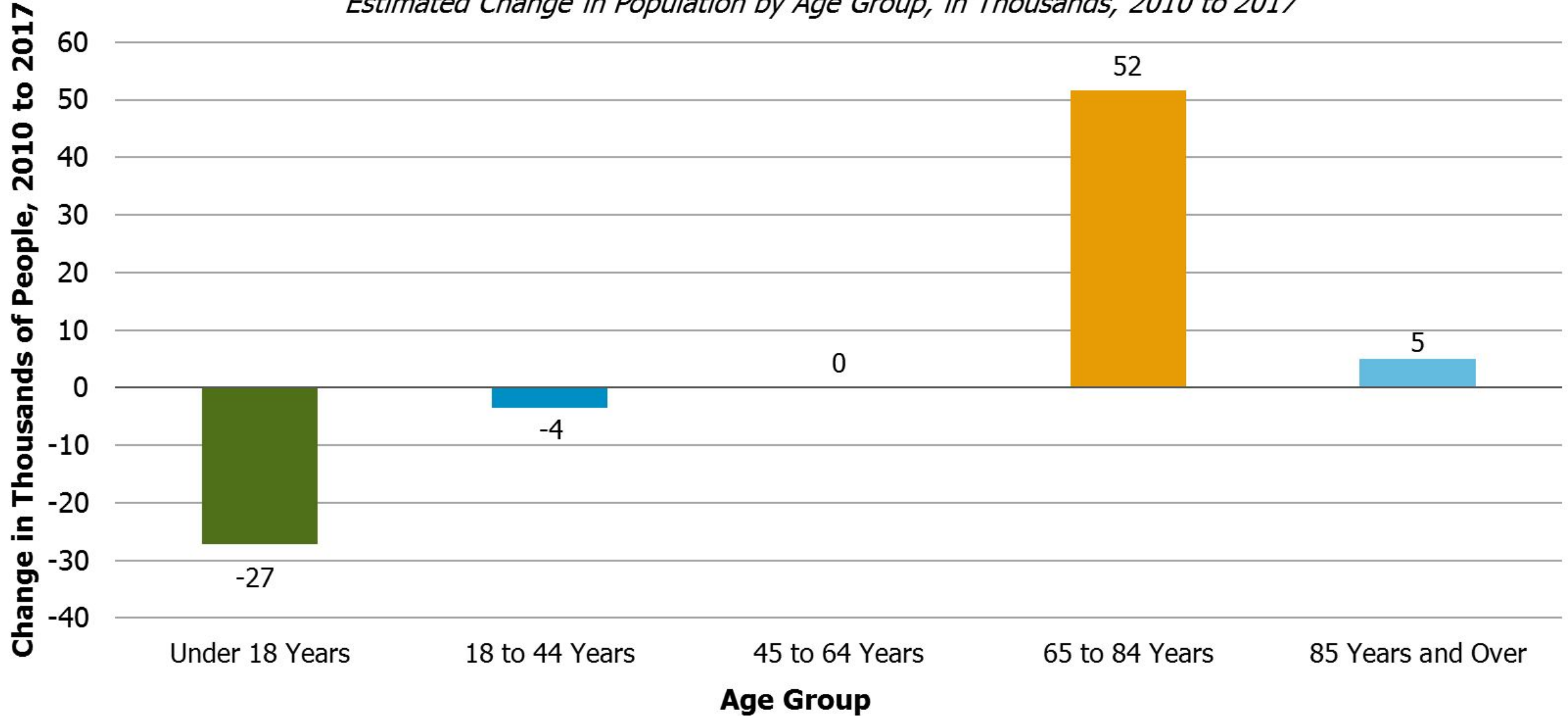
New Hampshire Population, Aged 25-64

New Hampshire Population Change Estimates by Age

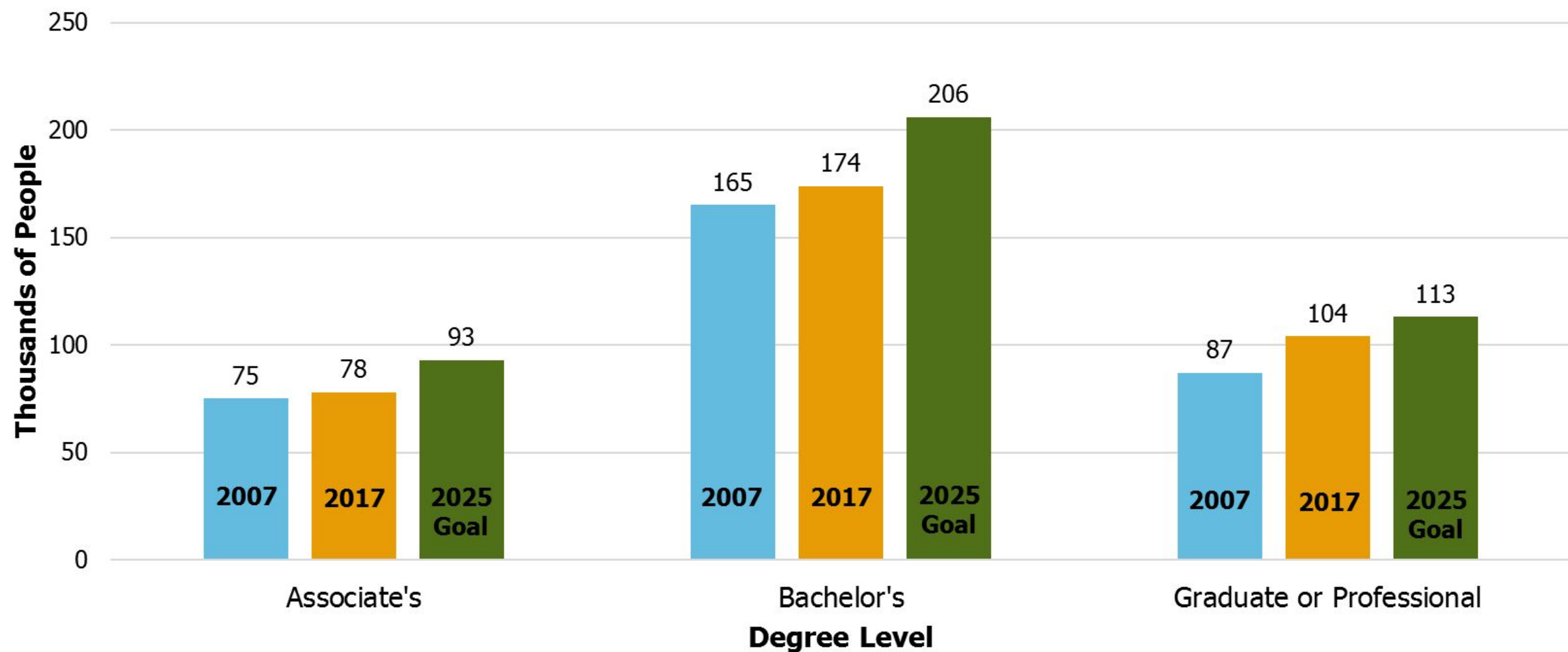
Estimated Change in Population by Age Group, in Thousands, 2010 to 2017

Estimated Thousands of People by Highest Attainment Level, Aged 25-64



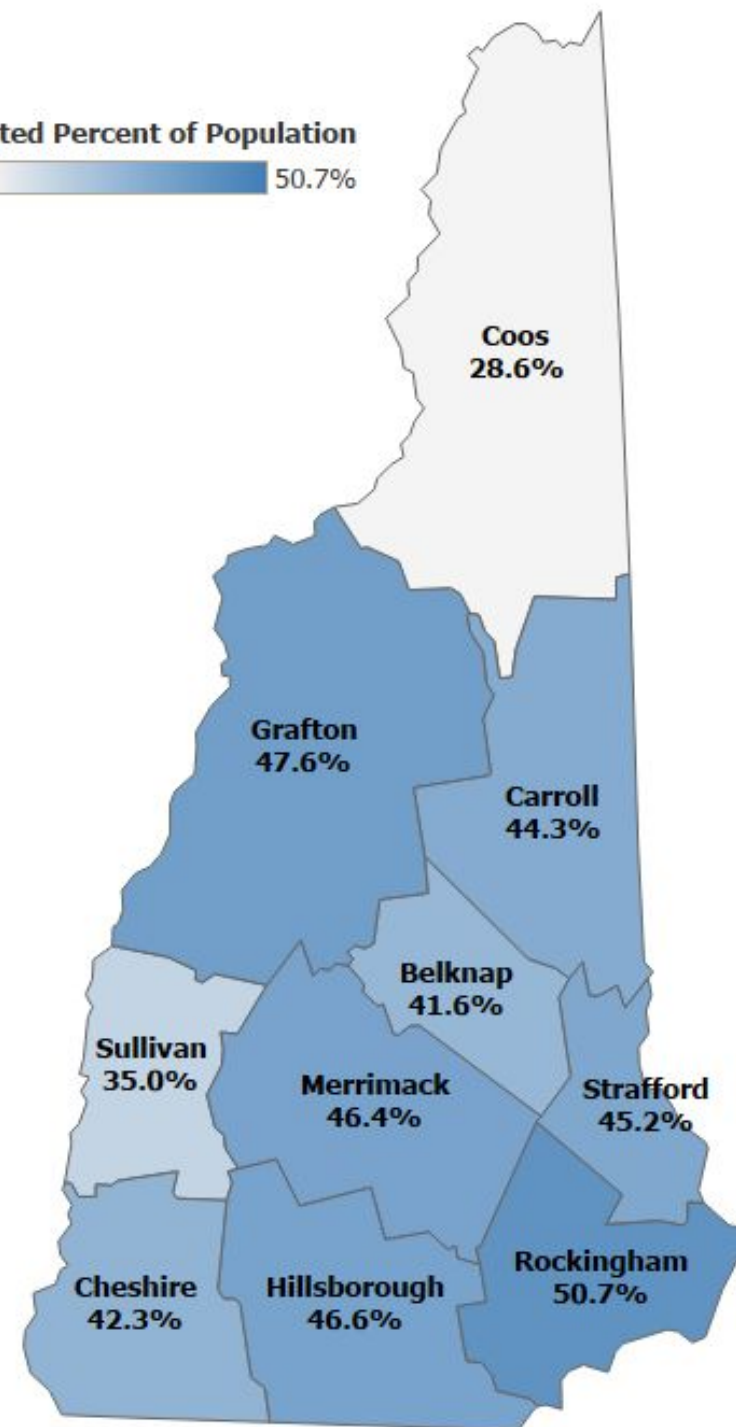

County Educational Attainment, 2013-2017

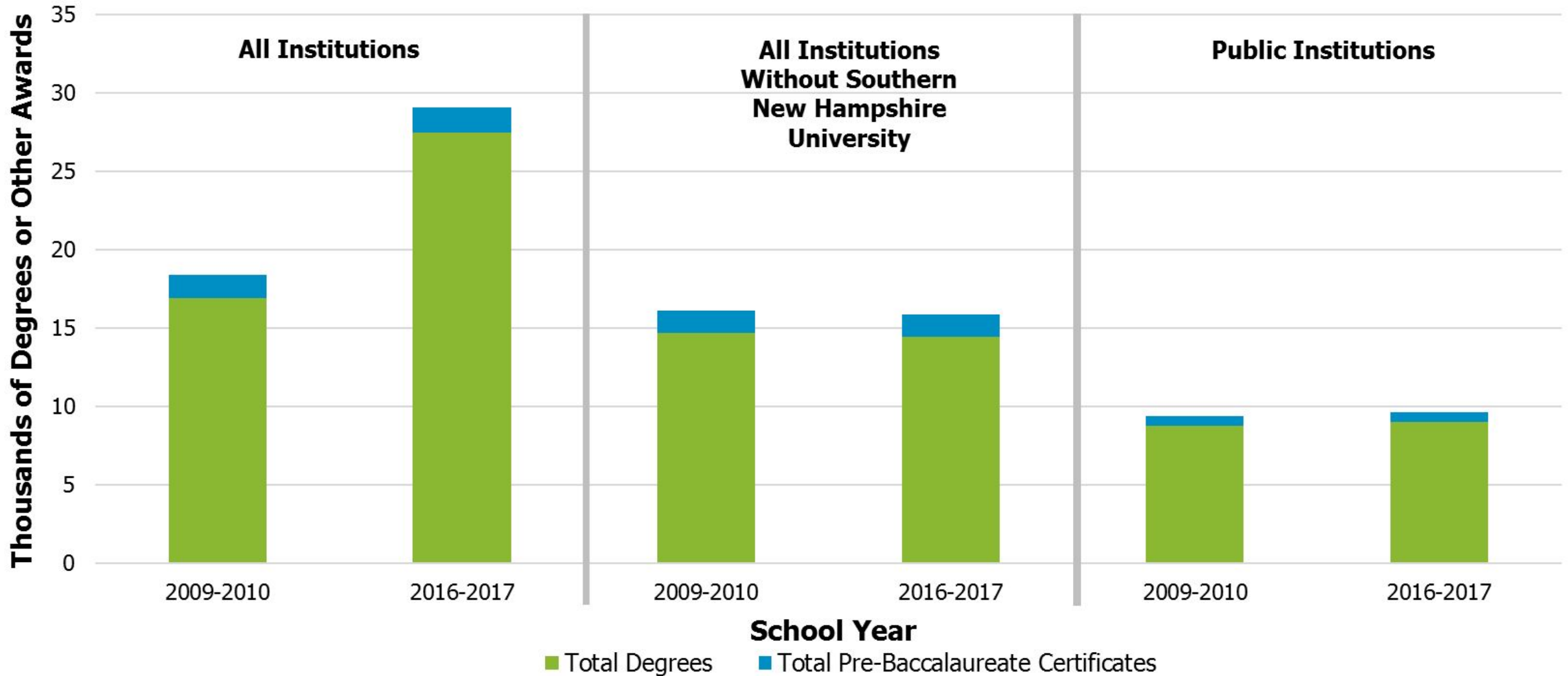

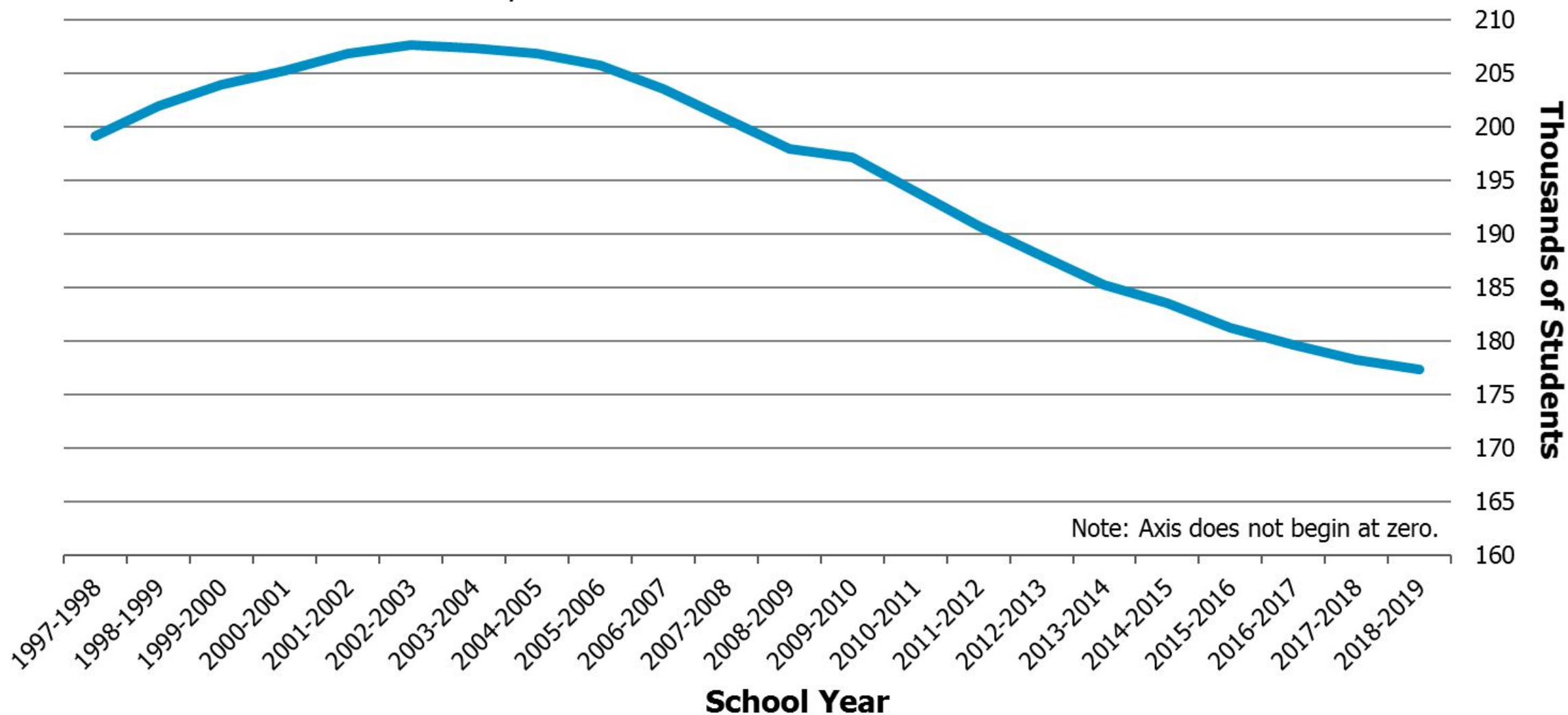
Degrees or Certificates Awarded by New Hampshire Institutions

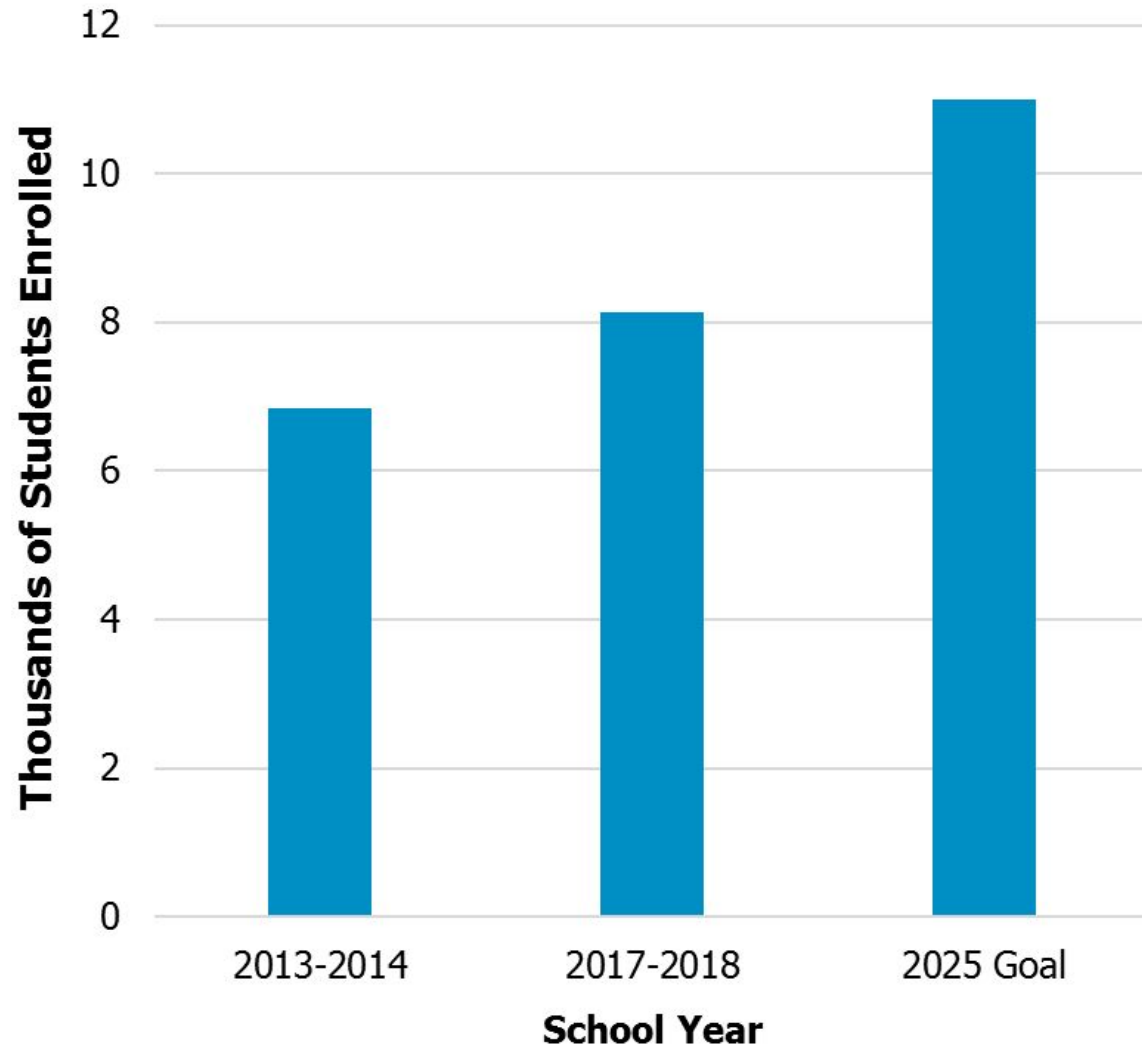
New Hampshire Statewide Enrollments in Public Schools

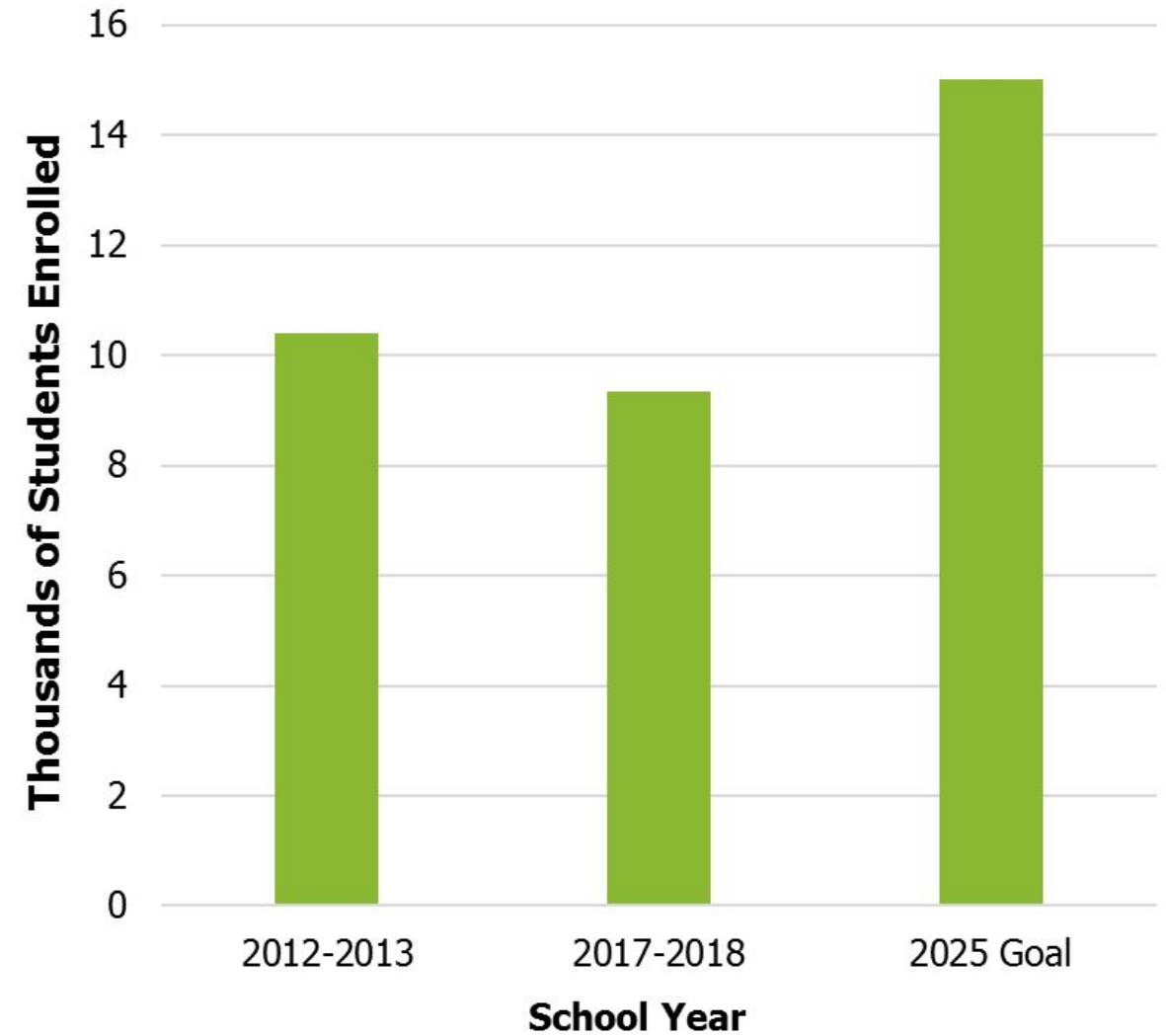

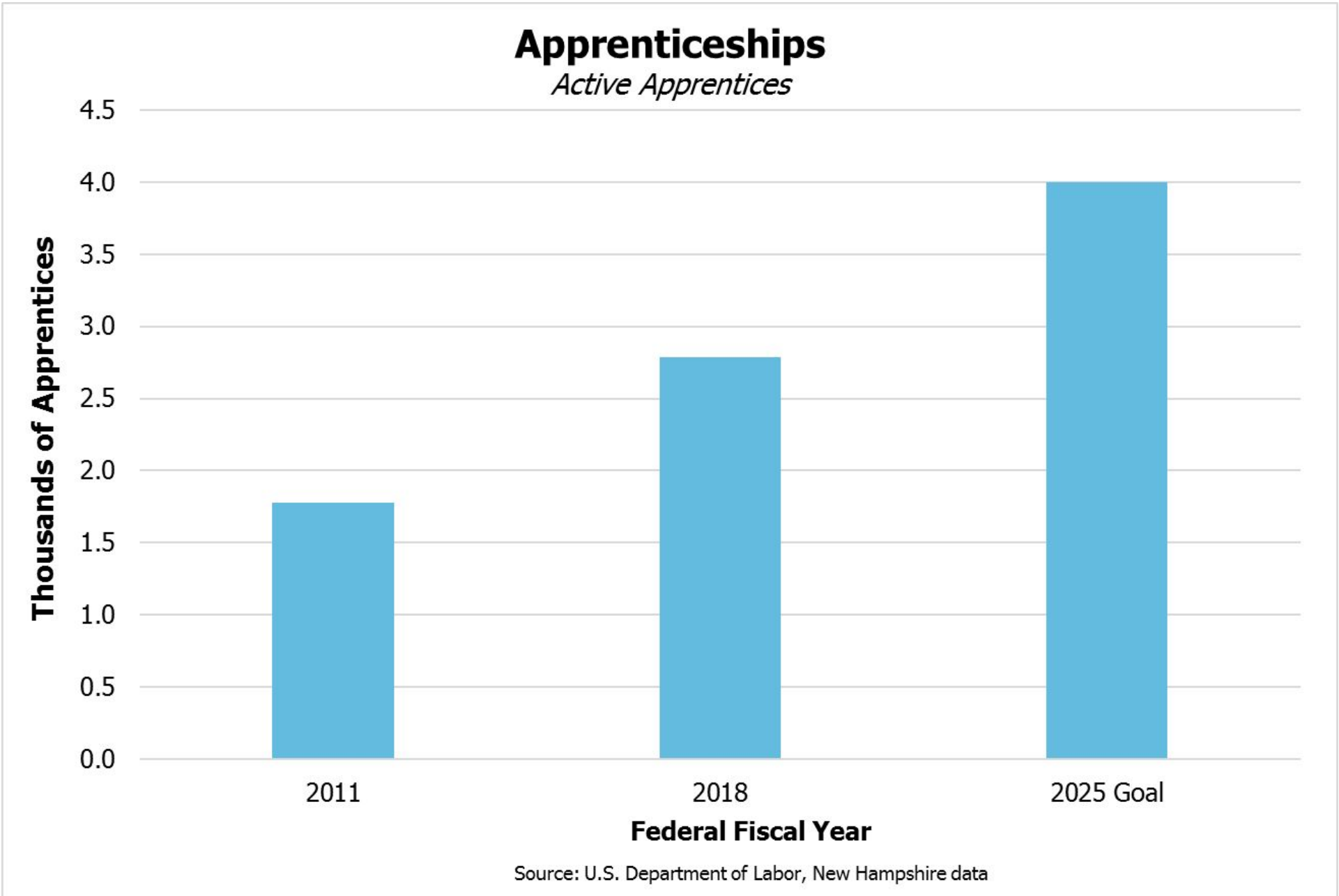

Career and Technical Education Enrollment

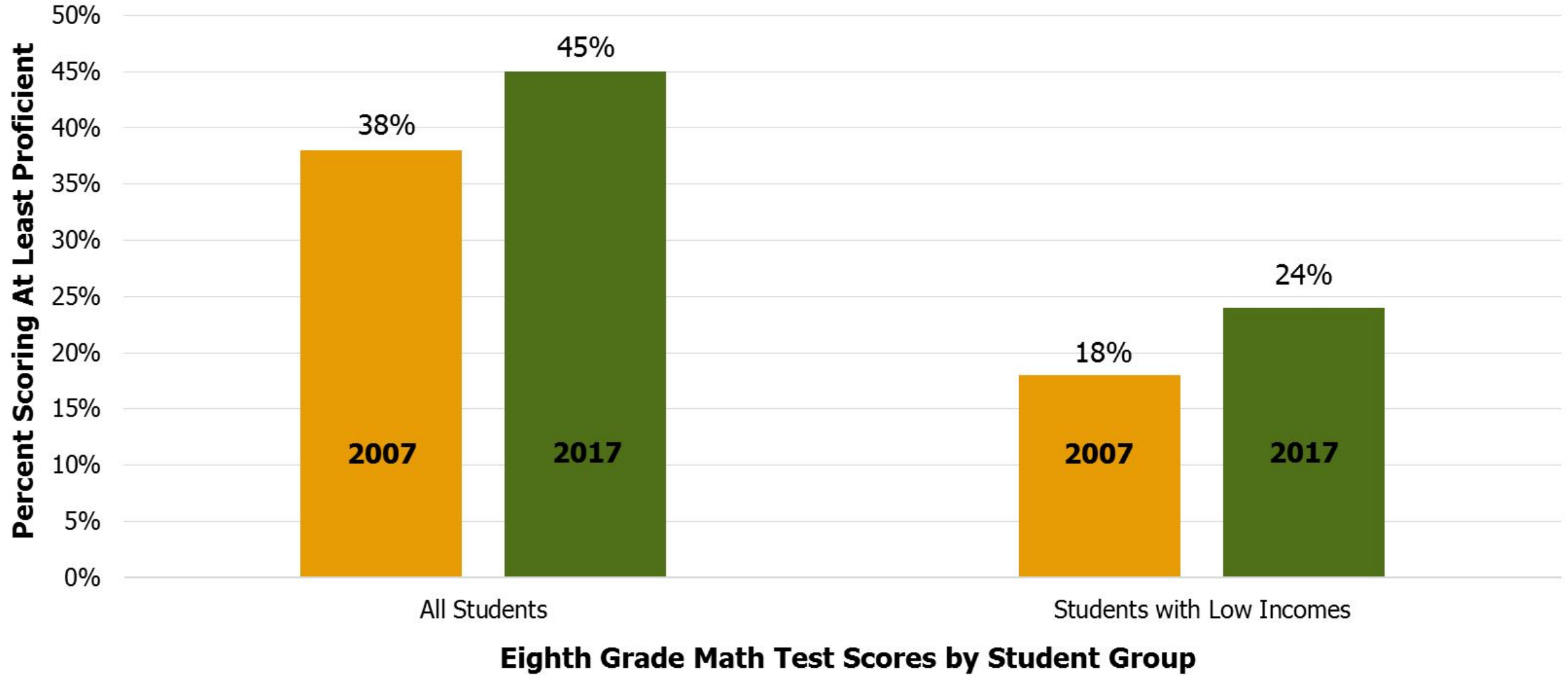
